SIGNATURE PROGRAM

Leadership Medina County's Signature Program brings together cross-industry, established leaders who reflect the diversity of Medina County. It provides an opportunity to cultivate new relationships, explore complex county and regional issues, and deepen leadership skills. At the end of the program, alumni are ready to increase their community impact.

The program includes an overnight opening retreat plus 11 class days from September through May. Tuition is \$2,100. Tuition assistance is available.

2017-2018 Program Information

Attendance at the opening retreat is mandatory. The class will explore topics such as history, business, industry, health care, human services, and many more. There is an allowance for a limited number of excused absence hours for the remaining nine class days.

Participants Will Gain:

- A broader and more profound understanding of complex community issues.
- A heightened recognition of the potential of civic leaders to influence community issues.
- An increased understanding of ways to be effective contributors within the community.
- A deep understanding of the value of collaborating with diverse partners to accomplish complex goals.

Signature program participants are established community and business leaders who desire to broaden their impact in Medina County. Ideal candidates for the Signature program:

- Have a proven record of service and commitment in their professions, community groups and neighborhoods.
- Must be a resident of or work in Medina County.
