Attendance Policy

The opening retreat is mandatory. A class member missing two (2) class days will receive a “Certificate of Attendance” at graduation instead of the “Graduation Acknowledgement (gift)” but will graduate with the class and have access to the LMC Membership Directory. The individual will have to make up one class day the following class year and must notify the executive director of attendance. A class member missing three (3) class days will not graduate with the class and will need to make up two (2) class days the following year. The individual must inform the executive director as to which class days will be attended. After the class days are made up within the next class year, the individual will graduate with the class, and have all membership privileges, including access to the on-line directory, when membership dues are paid.

The board understands that in a few cases unforeseen circumstances can arise. In the event that a class member misses two (2) class days, the issues involved, if deemed worthy by the Executive Director, will be reviewed by the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee and the board will determine what action should be taken.
