Junior Leadership Medina County (JrLMC) is designed to shape the future of high school students who reside in Medina County by developing individual leadership skills, promoting teamwork, and encouraging community involvement. The program runs from August through May and includes six class days that occur during the week, one weekend day, and one retreat comprised of a Friday evening and Saturday.
