



## Leadership Medina County LEAD Institute

Leadership Medina County’s LEAD Institute program is designed for those looking for professional development training and to further develop their leadership skills. Participants will be presented with the necessary tools, resources, information, and networking to benefit themselves and the businesses they support as they continue to grow both personally and professionally as community and business leaders. The program focuses on developing communication and strategic thinking skills.

The program runs from September – May on the 1st Thursday\* of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.; and includes lunch. Class size is limited to 40 individuals. Tuition is \$1,100 and includes all materials, texts, and assessments. Certificates will be issued to each participant upon completion of the program.

**Application Due Date: August 1, 2020**

Applicants will be notified of their status by August 15, 2020.

Participants in Leadership Medina County’s LEAD Institute program will be selected from those individuals who have submitted their applications by the deadline. Enrollment is limited to 40 participants.

Participants must be able to commit to the full class schedule and a class project. Class projects are selected at the Opening Retreat.
